Madison, Wis -- Madison Credit Union, in honor of its 75th year of serving members, is partnering with Second Harvest Foodbank of Southern Wisconsin. Throughout 2010, for every new member joining, Madison Credit Union is making a foodbank donation that provides approximately 75 meals to those in need.

Madison Credit Union, a Bauer Financial 5-Star rated credit union for its financial strength, was founded in 1936 by then Madison Mayor James Law and Water Utility Superintendent Leon Smith as a not-for-profit cooperative serving members' needs. Today, Madison Credit Union is \$30 million in assets, has 3690 members, and serves those living or working in Dane County. Its main office is located at 949 East Washington Avenue.
